The C.A.R.E. Program

(Collaboratory in Active Regenerative Ecologies)

is a bioregion-specific project that invites educators to an immersive summer residency in kayaks in the Hudson River Estuary.

In summer 2021 we paddled a 70 mile-loop (Hoboken-Croton

Point-Hoboken) honoring the daily ocean tides that gave the river

its Lenape name Mahicantuck (river that flows two ways).




Goals

- learning with the estuary and from ourselves as co-inhabitants in the bioregion | unlearning consumerist + colonial habits
- experimenting with governance, inclusive dynamics, decarbonized mobility and overall frugality
- building relationships of interconnectedness and responsibility
- acquiring literacy about a diversity of skills crucial for climate action
- bringing an overall sense of self-reliance and resilience in participants
- amplifying these literacies through educators-in-residence
- learning to live with uncertainties


